

**THE SWISS NATIONAL HERO ARNOLD VON WINKELRIED, WHO – ACCORDING TO
LEGEND – LAID DOWN HIS LIFE FOR HIS COUNTRY AT THE BATTLE OF SEMPACH ON
JULY 9, 1386**
